


### Break a job down into tasks

#### **Potential prompt**

- I am responsible for creating new content for our brand website.
- It should focus on our key messages and the impact on quality of life.
- Help me write the content including figures and graphs.

# Don't expect perfection

Apply the 80:20 principle





# Key principles

- Chat naturally
- More is more context, detail and examples
- Break tasks down into sub-tasks, and check each step
- Apply your own strengths
- Experiment with different sub-tasks
- Don't expect perfection (80% is great)

# Al applications in Medical Affairs

- Drafting emails, slides, and medical content
- Literature monitoring and synthesis
- Summarizing large or multiple documents
- Slide deck development using source content and strategy
- Training and educational material creation
- Marketing material review and compliance checks

- Real-world evidence monitoring and signal detection
- Strategy development and gap analysis
- Automated project reminders and action tracking.
